- ◆ **Globalisation:** technological, communicative, social, and cultural knowledge and skills to lead and succeed in the intensively connected global world.

Areas of collaborative academic excellence (ACAEs)

The areas of collaborative excellence represent areas in which the University is further developing expertise and activities to deepen its research impact through multi and interdisciplinary research and educational opportunities that cut across the Faculties and expanded strategic alliances with external partners, both public and private.
