SPECIFICATION: FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE PROPOSED BUSINESS SCHOOL AT MANGOSUTHU UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (MUT)

1. INTRODUCTION

Mangosuthu University of Technology (MUT) invites qualified consultancy firms to submit proposals for conducting a comprehensive feasibility study on the establishment of the MUT Business School. This study will assess the viability, sustainability, and strategic positioning of the Business School, ensuring alignment with MUT's vision, stakeholder needs, and national higher education policies.


2. BACKGROUND

MUT has approved, in principle, the concept of establishing a Business School to expand its Programme Qualification Mix (PQM), address gaps in postgraduate education, and contribute to local and national economic development. An internal feasibility study has been conducted, highlighting key strategic considerations, opportunities, and challenges. The findings indicate the necessity for an external feasibility study to provide objective, expert analysis on critical success factors.

3. OBJECTIVES OF THE FEASIBILITY STUDY

The selected consultancy will be expected to:

- Conduct a comprehensive market analysis, including a competitor landscape review.
- Determine the niche positioning and value proposition of the Business School.
- Identify the programmatic niche areas and features that would make for success of the enterprise.
- Assess the feasibility of accreditation for postgraduate programmes, including an MBA and DBA.
- Evaluate financial viability, including revenue models and potential funding sources, showing future financial trends.

- Consider main location options, including those such as the MegaCity site, the entrance of Umlazi township and alternative sites.
 - Recommend governance, resource, and operational structures, considering integration within the Faculty of Management Sciences.
 - Identify critical industry and stakeholder partnerships to enhance the “School’s” relevance and sustainability, giving impetus to its success.
 - Develop a critical path outlining key milestones from planning to establishment.
 - Assess risks and propose mitigation strategies.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

The feasibility study must cover the following areas, but is not limited to these areas:

4.1 Market Analysis

- Demand assessment for business education in KwaZulu-Natal and South Africa.
- Competitor analysis, including benchmarking against institutions such as UKZN, DUT, and TUT.
- Stakeholder consultation, including industry, local government, and potential students.

4.2 Academic Feasibility

- Programme mix and articulation pathways - this refers to variety of academic offerings, such as diplomas, postgraduate diplomas, Masters degrees (MBA), Doctoral programmes (DBA), executive education, short courses, other business-oriented certificated programmes and micro-credentials. The study should also look at how students can progress from one level of study to another. For example, a student with a Postgraduate Diploma in Business Administration should have a clear pathway to enter an MBA programme. Similarly, an MBA graduate may have options to pursue a Doctor of Business Administration (DBA) or other advanced studies.
- Accreditation feasibility and regulatory compliance with DHET, CHE, SAQA, and QCTO.
- Integration of interdisciplinary and executive education offerings - how the Business School at MUT will combine knowledge from different academic disciplines and cater to both academic and professional learners.

4.3 Financial Feasibility

- Budget projections, including cost estimates for infrastructure, staffing, and operations.
- Revenue generation strategies, including tuition fees, corporate sponsorships, and donor funding.
- Long-term financial sustainability model, with income trends.

4.4 Operational and Governance Structure

- Organisational structure and staffing requirements.
- Relationship with existing faculties, research directorate and other divisions within the university.
- Governance model and reporting structures.

4.5 Location and Infrastructure

- Evaluation of proposed sites, including MegaCity and on-campus options.
- Space requirements for classrooms, administration, and student facilities.
- ICT and blended learning infrastructure needs.

4.6 Risk Analysis and Mitigation Strategies

- Potential risks, including enrolment challenges, accreditation delays, and financial sustainability.
- Proposed mitigation measures.

4.7 Stakeholder Engagement Plan

- Engagement strategy for key external stakeholders, including industry, government, and donors.
- Partnerships for programme development and funding opportunities.

The experts engaged should incorporate all other aspects to be considered in a feasibility study of this nature and scope.

CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION
