- Must be a SA citizen
- Must have achieved a minimum pass rate of 60% in subjects enrolled for the previous semester/year.
- Must be a self-funded student with a combined household income of R350 000 to R600 000 per annum
- A student with a combined household income of R350 000 per annum who was denied funding by NSFAS will also be considered.

- Academic Results
- Certified copy of ID
- Identity documents of parents/guardians
- Proof of gross household income or affidavit of parents/guardians
- Motivation for funding to establish and consider the reasons for the factors that contributed to the delay in the delay in academic progression
- Any additional information or documents that would support your documents.
