Key Performance Areas:

- Respond to and report accidents, injuries, or emergencies.
- Provide orientations and guidance on using fitness machines correctly.
- Ensure a high standard of customer service by answering questions and addressing member complaints.
- Monitor the gym floor constantly to assist users and ensure a welcoming environment.
- Open and close the facility, including securing rooms and equipment.
- Supervise staff, manage schedules, and ensure adequate staffing levels.
- Monitor attendance and, if applicable, maintain game records.
- Act as a liaison between staff, management, and members.
- Keep records, such as daily cleaning checklists or equipment maintenance logs.
