CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- 1 This document must form part of all bids¹ invited.

- 2 Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).² Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.

2. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

The Mangosuthu University of Technology (MUT), through the Office of the Vice-Chancellor (OVC), invites qualified and experienced service providers to submit quotations for the facilitation of an Executive Management Committee (EMC) Planning Session.

The University is currently navigating a period of transition following sudden and unplanned changes in executive leadership positions. The Council has appointed an Interim Vice-Chancellor to lead the University during this season. Consequently, it is imperative that the Interim Vice-Chancellor and all executives develop a robust plan to restore stability and ensure the University delivers on its mandate.

3. EVENT DETAILS

Event: EMC Planning Session 2026

Dates: 20– 21 May 2026 (2 Days)

Time: 08:30 – 16:30 (Daily)

Venue: Off-campus venue (To ensure maximum focus and adequate utilisation of resources).

Participants: All Executive Management Committee (EMC) members.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

The successful service provider (Facilitator) will be required to:

1. **Programme Design:** Shape the programme agenda against the set objectives of restoring stability and achieving institutional strategic goals.
2. **Facilitation:** Lead the two-day off-campus planning session professionally.
3. **Strategic Alignment:** Assist the EMC in crafting a 2026 engagement strategy that addresses internal challenges.
4. **Reporting:** Ensure that a comprehensive report is generated at the end of the session documenting decisions, action plans, and strategic directives.
5. **Accountability:** Reinforce collective accountability at the executive level during the sessions.

5. REQUIRED CREDENTIALS AND EXPERIENCE

To ensure the effectiveness of the session, the Facilitator must possess credentials comparable to high-level institutional experts. Specifically, the candidate must demonstrate:

- **Sector Experience:** Proven expertise and experience within the Higher Education sector, with a deep understanding of university governance and strategic planning.
- **Executive Development:** Prior experience directing Executive Development and Institutional Culture programmes.
- **Strategic Alignment:** Demonstrated ability to align personal leadership purpose with institutional strategy.
- **Change Management:** Experience working with executive leadership teams during periods of organizational transition, instability, or interim leadership arrangements.
- **Track Record:** Evidence of successful facilitation of similar high-level planning sessions (references required).

6. EVALUATION PROCESS

6.1 Introduction

To ensure that all bidders are afforded the opportunity to compete on an equal footing and to enable the Mangosuthu University of Technology to evaluate the Bids received on an equal basis, a pre-described process of evaluating bids will be followed.

6.2 Methodology

The evaluation of bids will be divided into three (3) stages:

- Stage 1: Mandatory Requirements.
- Stage 2: Functionality.
- Stage 3: Price and BBBEE

6.2.1 Stage 1: Mandatory Requirements.

Mandatory documentation – whether all required documentation and/or certification have been included.

- The MUT has defined minimum mandatory criteria listed in the table below that must be met by the Bidder for the MUT to accept an offer for evaluation.
- Where there is failure to comply with the mandatory requirements or for any reason that MUT is unable to verify any of the mandatory documents, the bid will not progress to the next stage of evaluation.
- Documents submitted in support of this Bid must be documents of the Bidding entity. It is not permitted that documents submitted pertain to different companies or units within a group. As an example, a Bidder cannot submit its own BBBEE certificate but the financial statements of its parent or another company in the same group. Similarly, a Bidder cannot submit its own financial statement, but the BBBEE certificate, SARS certificate, etc. of other companies in the group.

6.2.2 STAGE 2 FUNCTIONALITY

The evaluation criteria for functionality considers the bidder's previous experience and ability, quality, reliability, viability and durability of all equipment, goods and or services as well as the Bidders technical capacity and ability to execute and maintain a contract.

- No bid will be considered further unless the minimum qualifying score of 70 points for functionality has been achieved.
- Only bidders scoring minimum of 70 points and more shall be considered for Stage 3 dealing with Price & BBBEE.

6.3.3 STAGE 3 PRICE AND BBEE

6.3.3.1 The following preference point systems are applicable to invitations to tender: - the 80/20 system for requirements with a Rand value of up to R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included); and - the 90/10 system for requirements with a Rand value above R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included).

6.3.3.2 Points for this tender shall be awarded for:

(a) PRICE and BBEE

Only Bids that achieved the minimum qualifying score/percentage of 70 % for functionality will be considered further in terms of the relevant preference point system.

POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

THE 80/20 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

80/20

$$P_s = 80 \left(1 - \frac{P_t - P_{\min}}{P_{\min}} \right)$$

Where

P_s = Points scored for price of bid under consideration

P_t = Price of bid under consideration

P_{\min} = Price of lowest acceptable bid
